### **Club Training Payment Change**

Important changes are happening to your club training fees due to the new entry system installed at the Basildon Sporting Village. **Failure to use the new payment system will result in members being unable to access the stadium.**

From 1<sup>st</sup> May 2011 Basildon AC will only accept training payments by Standing Order from your Bank. This brings us in line with other clubs and also moves us in to a more modern era with the new Basildon Sporting Village opening on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2011.

The standing order will be monthly and will cover the value of training per month based on 2 training session per week for 4 weeks (8 sessions in total).

The price will be as follows:

**Seniors = £20** (8 sessions at £2.50)

**Juniors = £12** (8 sessions at £1.50) A Junior is an U18 or an athlete in full time education

Concessions are available ie

- 1) For University students studying away from home using the facilities during holiday periods
- 2) Hardship cases
- 3) Other exceptional circumstances

Please discuss any of the above with your coach

The above is not to be confused with the Club annual renewal membership fees due on 1st April. This is a separate payment and can be paid by cheque or cash as follows:

**Annual Membership Seniors = £25**

**Annual Membership Juniors = £15** - A Junior is an U18 or athletes in full time education

The membership fee includes England Athletics registration fee of £5 per athlete.
